This represents a serious loss of unique cultural and social resources. Safety measures must be taken to keep museums open as much as possible. CIPEG recognises the need to allocate adequate funding and to develop policies that will allow museums to continue to carry out their vital role in society for generations to come.

The recent flood that affected the Sudanese people and heritage is a great tragedy. CIPEG expresses its deep concern about this and offers its support to Sudanese colleagues by bringing awareness to this state of emergency that has resulted in loss of lives and homes, displacement of people, and threats to archaeological sites.
